The Rates Rebate provided by the Department of Internal Affairs and administered by your local Council applies from 1st July 2018 for the new rating year.

If you received a rebate in the last rating year you will automatically be sent an appointment for this year. If you have never received a Rebate before but think you may gualify do not hesitate to contact the Council and they will assess you for this. If your income is a little over the standard amount for a rebate you may still qualify for a partial rebate.

Total Mobility

Total Mobility is a nationwide scheme that provides a transport subsidy to help people with disabilities stay connected within their community.

If you no longer drive a motor vehicle and have a disability that prevents you from using public transport, you may be eligible for a 50% subsidy (up to a maximum of \$25 per trip) on eligible door-todoor transport to help you get around.

To confirm your eligibility you will need to contact a Total Mobility Agent and undergo an assessment to ensure you meet the requirements. There may be a charge for this.

Flu Vaccination

This vaccination is available each year free of charge for those 65 years of age and over, or those with a specified medical condition. It takes up to 2 weeks for the flu vaccine to provide protection. Contact your local GP or Medical Centre to make arrangements to have one if you so wish.



Shingles Vaccination

THIS IS NOW AVAILABLE FREE FOR THOSE 65 TO 80 YEARS OF AGE.

You can only get shingles if you've had chickenpox in the past (usually as a child). While anyone, who has recovered from chickenpox may develop shingles, the risk of shingles increases as you get older. Contact your local GP or Medical Centre if you wish to take advantage of this offer.

A Message from the Ministry of Social Development

They wish to advise that they have launched a Safe to Talk helpline. This provides free confidential information and support to people affected by sexual harm.
